Rental Housing Financing

- New Construction
- Preservation/Rehabilitation



- Examples of what we can finance:
 - Predevelopment early stage third party costs to determine feasibility, develop funding applications etc.
 - Acquisition of land or existing building
 - Construction new or rehab



Rental Housing Financing

• Short term


- Interest only
- Repayment from other project financing
- Longer term, amortizing financing
 - Repayment from a project's revenue streams (typically rents)





For Sale Housing Financing

- Subdivisions
- In Fill New Homes
- Rehabilitation of Existing Homes




- Examples of what we can finance:
 - Predevelopment
 - Acquisition of land or homes
 - Site/Infrastructure Development
 - Home construction spec or pre-sold



For Sale Housing Financing

- Short term financing only
 - Repayment from sale of lots or homes or project's other financing/funding sources






Self Help/Sweat Equity Housing


- SHOP Competitive 90% forgivable loan resource for land acquisition and site development costs
- 0% loan capital for land acquisition and site development costs





Property Eligibility








HAC Loans in Texas


